



Frequently Asked Questions

How do I stay connected to my group?

- Outside of your regular meeting time, face-to-face or conversations by phone are most ideal. However, text message, email, Facebook (groups), are good resources as well.

I like the idea of a Facebook page! How would I set up a page just for my group?

- Facebook really is a great way to remind your group of upcoming meetings and activities and to share prayer requests outside of your group meeting time. You will receive these instructions via email within the next few days.

Cornerstone wants to track attendance. How do I do this?

- Each week you'll receive an email reminding you to submit your attendance through Planning Center and it only takes a few minutes. You'll click boxes to note who was there and who wasn't...pretty simple.

What is Planning Center?

- Planning Center serves multiple functions for Cornerstone Church. For our Group Leaders, it's the primary hub for tracking group attendance and downloading resources. You'll receive more information within the next few days.

My group is following the weekend messages. How do I get my lesson plan that follows the message?

- There are 5 ways to get the lesson:
 - Website: There's a link from the [Group Leader Resource page](#) of our website.
 - Facebook: If you are on Facebook, we'll add you to our Group Leader page and you will be able to download materials there.
 - Planning Center: Download from the Leader's resources tab.
 - Email: If you prefer that it's emailed to you, please let us know by emailing Crystal (crobertson@cornerstonesi.org).
 - Your Campus: A few copies will be available at the Connect table/front desk in the lobby.

Some group members have kids who can be a distraction at times. What kind of childcare options are there?
