



Set Up A Private Facebook Group

Facebook can be a great way to stay connected with others. Regarding Groups, many leaders set up private Facebook groups to stay connected with their group members. Below, you'll find instructions on how to do this if you so choose.

Instructions:

- Log into your personal Facebook account.
- You will see a section on the left-hand side of the page titled "Groups".
- On the very bottom of that section you will see a plus sign and then "create group." Click it.
- A white box will then appear and ask for your group's name. Type in what you have decided to call you group. For example, "Robertson Study Group."
- Next, you'll add members to this group. You do this by typing their name in the box, and they should pop up as you type their name as long as you are friends with them.
- When are you finished adding members, select either closed or secret group. Do not make your group public. This will deter people from wanting to post prayer requests within the group.
- Then hit the button on the bottom of the box called "create." You can then choose an icon if you would like or skip that step.
- Now your group has been created on Facebook. You can then add more information to your group. You can add a description, add pictures, and you can always add new members at any time.
